Forwarding of the Joint Circular No.37 dated 01/10/2021

The Federations and CDRA have extended their warm greetings and congratulations to all the Defence Civilian Employees for their overwhelming participation in the Black Day programme today on 1st Oct. 2021 when the Government implemented the operation of the 7 non-viable Corporations by disintegrating the 41 Ordnance Factories in to 7 non viable Corporations/Companies. A Joint Circular No.37 dated 01/10/2021 issued in this regard is enclosed as **Annexure-I** of this Special Circular. Photographs received from the Black Day programme and lunch boycott is enclosed as **Annexure-II** of this special circular. At OCF Avadi more than 100 hundred retired employees came and participated in the Black Day demonstration.

AIDEF's Case against Corporatisation of Ordnance Factories came for hearing at Madras High Court today (01.10.2021)

Yesterday we have informed you that as assured by the Addl. Solicitor General, the Govt. has not filed its counter on our writ petition against Corporatisation on 30/09/2021. Since our Senior lawyer appeared and asked for interim relief, the petition was posted for hearing today. The Addl. Solicitor General appeared in the court and informed that Govt. orders are already issued for protecting all the service conditions of the employees during the two years deemed deputation period and there should not be any apprehension in this regard on their service matters. However our Senior Lawyer insisted that from 1st Oct. 2021onwards even though the Government order says that all the service condition would be protected during the deemed deputation period, there are many issues including financial conditions of the Corporations to be addressed to meet the salary and other expenditures. At this juncture the ASG informed the court that Min. of Defence informed him that the Govt. has transferred Rs.7000 Crores to the 7 Corporations and hence there will not be any problem for Corporations to meet the financial requirements. After this statement of ASG the court directed the ASG to file the counter by 08/10/2021 and after that our Senior Lawyer has to file rejoinder for the same. Accordingly the petition is posted for hearing on 25/10/2021.
