## Decisions of the Meeting of the National Coordination Committee of Electricity Employees & Engineers

Virtual meeting of the NCCOEEE took place on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Shri Shelendra Dubey, presided over the meeting. On behalf of our federation Com krishna Bhoyar secretary participated and expressed our stand.

- 1) At present the central Govt in the first Parliament session of Budget ie starting from January 31, 2022 not initiating the proposal of legislation Electricity (Amendment) Bill 2021, This is because the govt has committed that they will place the Bill 2021 in parliament only after consultations and discussions with the stake holders.
- 2) In View of the above it is unanimously decided to postpone the strike call on 1st February 2022
- 3) The second session of parliament on Budget will start in March till that time elections in 5 states will also be over, therefore we have to be alert and ready to fight all attempts of the Govt if the Govt without discussions place the bill in March Parliament session.
- 3) The constituents of NCCOEEE noted with grave concern that even after shameful retreat of the Central Govt over three form bills and written commitment on Elect. (Amendment) Bill 2021, Efforts are afoot to privatize the power sector of India. Efforts to privatise Jammu & Kashmir is the glaring example. There the transmission assets

were tried to transfer by formation of a Joint Venture Committee. The Govt also concentrated on privatisation of other Union Territories.

- 4) Similarly in Chandigarh Union Territory, unlawful bidding process for privatisation is carried out despite the stay order of Hon High court Chandigarh.
- 5) The power workers & engineers of Chandigarh power utility have unitedly apposed this move and decided to observe one day strike on 1st February 2022.
- 6) Similar to Chandigarh the united forum of power workers and engineers of Pondicherry also resolve to observed solidarity strike on 1st February 2022 in support of striking power sector employees of Chandigarh.
- 7) When both the union territories ie. Chandigarh & Pondicherry are on strike on 1st February 22, NCCOEEE cannot be a spectator, therefore decided to organise massive 'Nationwide protest Demonstration' on 1st February 22 in solidarity support. All our Unions & Associations are requested to ensure that 'Protest Demonstration' is organised in all the states with utmost unity and huge participation. Each constituent will also send Memorandum addressed to lieuftnunt Governor of Chandigarh & Pondicherry.
- 8) AIFEE's General Secretary will attend Chandigarh meeting on 1st February 2022. Our Punjab unit will reach Chandigarh in large scale to participate in the massive demonstration. Similarly at Pondicherry our comrades from Tamilnadu, kerala and Karnataka Should Join in massive demonstration.
- 9) Two days National strike on 23rd and 24th February 2022.

NCCOEEE resolved to take part in the two days All India strike a call given by the National Convention of workers held at New Delhi on 11th November 2021.
