Sub: Strike by Station Masters of Indian Railway on 31.05.2022 – reg.

As you are already aware, the Secretary General of All India Station Masters' Association has served a strike notice on the Chairman, Railway Board (CEO) with five point charter of demands, non-acceptance of which will be followed by a MASS CASUAL LEAVE by all Station Masters of IR on 31.05.2022. The following are the demands of the strike:

- Fill up all vacancies
- Restore the Night Duty Allowance to all Railway employees without any ceiling limit.
- Grant the benefit of MACP in the cadre of Station Masters with effect from 01.01.2016 instead of 16.02.2018.
- To restructure the cadres with revised designations.
- Grant Safety and Stress allowance to Station Masters for their contribution to safe and punctual running of trains.

The above demands also pertain to other cadres and Railway employees other than Station Masters. All the demands touch the sentiments of all railway employees in one way or other.

The times ahead for Trade unions in general and Railway Trade unions in particular are going to be very tough. The Government at the Centre is pushing through anti-labour legislations and promoting anarchy and denigrating the dignity of labour through its policies to appease the corporates. The need for more unity among Trade unions and congruity in the ideals, purpose, strategies and standards of railway trade unions cannot be overemphasized at this juncture.

In the above circumstances the strike called by AISMA assumes more importance and significance in fetching the fruits to the working class. In this connection I am directed to request your cooperation and solidarity for the strike call given by AISMA for the MASS

CASUAL LEAVE on 31.05.2022. The rank and file of your esteemed organization may be sensitized about the mode of strike and its demands.
