## Central Circular

To  
All Central Office Bearers & Zonal Secretaries of AILRSA

Sub.: Proceedings of Central Working Committee (CWC) meeting of  
AILRSA held at Naihati/ER on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2022.

Central Working Committee of All India Loco Running Staff Association was held at Naihati (WB) on 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 under the president ship of Presidium consisting of Com. L. Mony / Central President, Com. N. B. Dutta / Working President & Com. Ramsharan / Vice-President. Meeting adopted the following resolutions.

- 1) This CWC meeting vehemently protest against the instruction from the CRB to frame Mail / Express crew links with an average fortnightly working hours of 100 hours, It may be noted that Railway Board had decided to limit the fortnightly working hours of Mail / Express crew to 90 in early 70s, when the length of trains were just 10 to 12 coaches, number of signals too less and speed was 100 Kmph and even less. So the meeting demand to withdraw the instruction to ensure safety.
- 2) Central Railway had issued an order no. T108.L53 Diesel Link dated 20/04/2022 through which long hood working of Diesel Locomotives are prohibited for coaching trains. We appreciate the Zonal Administration for realising the potential danger of long hood working, though hundreds of our colleagues were subjected to the trauma of SPAD caused due to long hood working. This meeting demand the Railway Board to prohibit Long Hood working of Diesel Locomotives throughout the rail network.
- 3) This meeting demand the Railway Administration to adopt a time bound programme to provide toilets, drinking water, Air conditioner etc. in all locomotives. The lady running staff are suffering inhuman deprivation of human rights on account of the above deficiencies.

- 4) There are many reports of curtailing fundamental rights of workers by divisional officers which are highly condemnable. Com. Paras Kumar / General Secretary of SER was booked to office treating the mass demonstration and delegation to GM / SER on 21/03/2022 as part of all India agitation, as an unlawful act. Eleven comrades of Kazipet lobby of SCR are issued charge sheets for raising slogans in protest against unlawful suspension of a Loco Pilot. Sr. DEE / SEC have now issued show cause notice for all those protested at Ballampally of SCR, against expulsion a crew from train who were proceedings to HQ on duty pass. Com. U. Baburajan / General Secretary / SR was punished by withholding his annual increment for one year citing the reason that his speech was aired in media. This meeting urge the Railway Administration to cancel all the above penal actions and suitably advice all divisions and zones to protect the fundamental rights of workers.
- 5) In Eastern Railway in many places Rest Rooms even without toilets are utilized as running room at many places like TDLE, MCCS and Godda (MLDT Divn.), Deoghar and Dumka (ASN Divn.). This meeting demand to abandon those rest rooms or upgrade them to the standard of running rooms.

**Programme of actions:-**

A vigorous campaign and serious agitation is most essential on the current attack on running staff such as:-

- a) Denial of NDA
- b) Extension of crew beat
- c) By passing of HQ
- d) Tightening of crew links
- e) Withdrawal of box boys
- f) Harassments in the name of LRS
- g) Problem faced by lady running staff
- h) Running of crack goods
- i) Deterioration of running rooms
- j) Unlawful JPOs overburdening running staff
- k) Increasing the quantum of penalties in SPAD etc.  
along with the pending grievances in pay allowances and working hours.

**Three stage action programme is decided:-**

- A. One day mass hunger fast in all lobbies on 6<sup>th</sup> June'2022 (Monday)
- B. Central office bearers tour programme in June / July.

Four tour programmes to be organised:-

1) SR, SWR, SCR & ECoR

Com. K. C. James shall plan the programme in consultation with respective Zonal Secretaries. Com. K. Ravichandran, Com. M. M. Roly & Com. S. K. Chowbe shall be the team members.

2) SER, ECR, ER, SECR, METRO & NFR

Com. Paras Kumar shall plan & organise the tour. Com. C. K. Sarkar, Com. R. C. Patel, Com. R. R. Bhagat, Com. Mahadev Bhattacharjee & Com. Goutam Dasgupta are the team members.

3) NE, NCR & NR

Com. Padam Singh shall plan and organise the tour programme. Com. S. P. Singh, Com. C. P. Singh & Com. R. K. Rana will be the team members.

4) CR, WR, WCR & NWR

Com. M. P. Deo shall plan and organise the tour programme. Com. D. S. Koparkar, Com. Luna Ram Siyag & Com. Shyam Nair are the team members.

Com. M. N. Prasad, Com. N. B. Dutta, Com. L. Mony and Com. Jit Singh Tank are to be intimated about the tour programme and conveyance to be arranged if they give consent to attend. Com. N. B. Dutta made consent to attend ECoR & ER. All central office bearers are part of the tour programme and attend all meetings at their convenience.

C. 12 hours mass sit in hunger fast at Jantar Mantar, New Delhi and also at one place in every division and entire running staff On duty / Off duty shall observe fast simultaneously in the month of August' 2022. Date will be advised by Secretary General.

Next course of action (direct action of stoppage of train for a day or 10 mins.) will be decided by CWC meeting following the hunger fast agitation.

Note:- The decision to go for litigation against denial of NDA is deferred for the time being as such a court case may be come a favour to Railway Administration sighting the issue as sub-judice.

**Decisions:-**

1) All India BGM

Golden Jubilee BGM will be held at BZA, the birth place of AILRSA in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of November' 2022. The conference shall be for three days:-

The 1<sup>st</sup> day will be spared for Golden Jubilee celebrations and then BGM on 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> day. Total no. of delegates will be 800 – 1000 and delegate fee per Delegate / Visitor will be Rs.1500/-.

SCR will mobilize a fund of Rs.30 lacs within their zone and rest of the expenses will be shared by the central committee and neighbouring zones. Reception committee shall meet soon and advice the date, venue & expected expenditure to Secretary General.

2) Membership 2022:-


AILRSA has achieved the landmark of 50,000 membership in the year 2021 and the central committee meeting greet all those worked hard to achieve this victory. We shall aim to increase the membership to 60,000 this year and shall complete the same within three months. All general secretaries are directed to inform their requirement of membership books in writing to Com. Panday / Asstt. Treasurer for sending the same through courier. Com. Padam Singh and team may help the Asstt. Treasurer for this task. (Mobile no. of Com. Mohan Chand Panday – 9717632376).

3) Recognition of AILRSA

A reminder representation shall be sent to Sri Naveen Kumar EP/ Policy on the issue of recognition for AILRSA and a delegation to meet him at Railway Board. Com. M. P. Deo, Com. Ramsharan, Com. Padam Singh & Com. C. P. Singh are decided as the delegation. Com. M. P. Deo shall arrange for the appointment and inform Secretary General and other office bearers so that they also shall accompany the delegation if possible.
