Bank Employees on War Path !


All the unions from Central Bank of India are agitating against large scale closure of the branches, Bypassing the bipartisan in the decision making process on the issues affecting employees, large scale administrative transfers of the employees etc. As a part of this agitation employees have decided to go on strike on 30th & 31st May 2022. All the unions from Bank of Baroda are on agitation against banks decision to outsource the job of sweepers. As a part of agitation Bank of Baroda employees are going on strike on 30th May 2022. Employees from Punjab & Sindh Bank are on agitation against outsourcing & for adequate recruitment. As a part of the agitation employees from Punjab & Sindh Bank are going on strike on 30th May 2022.

Employees from Catholic Syrian Bank are already on agitation with a demand to implement 11th Bipartite settlement . Federal Bank employees are on agitation against managements attempt to suppress the voice of dissent of the union representatives by attacking them. Employees from Bank of India & Bank of Maharashtra are already on agitation with a demand for recruitment & their opposition to outsourcing. Employees Union from UCO bank in recently held all India central committee meeting at Nagpur have decided to launch an agitation on the issue of recruitment. In almost all the banks employees are agitating for recruitment. In last 5 to 6 years government has implemented all their social sector schemes through banks resulting into huge workload & at the same time large scale retirement has taken place in the banks resulting into huge pressures & stress & strain on the front line employees leading for unrest with the employees & it is thus that employees unions from almost all the banks are taking the decision to agitate by

bridging their differences on the lines on which they used to fight for wages.
