This is to bring to your kind notice that after Formation of Telangana under your leadership and You became Chief Minister of newly born State, Development activities taken in all fronts and State Government owned Singareni Collieries Company Limited also giving it's Development share to the State.

During separate Telangana agitation time Singareni employees participated in Indefinite Strike call given by you and this strike culminated to declaration of separate Telangana by Central Government. You may recall your admiration of Singareni employees are as " CHEEKATI SURYULU " as the employees giving Coal by striving to give light (velugu) to Nation. You are very much aware that Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. is giving Profits and it is only big industry in Telangana State and spread in to 4 Old Districts.

Our Retired employees having a grievance: After retirement from the services of the company Retired employees are deprived of Medical facilities at their sunset days. Some of Retired employees covered under CPRMS-NE scheme on contributing from their hard earned money. But Medical card issued by Scl is not honoured by several Empanelled hospitals. Even though amount is contributed by NCWA retired employees inline with retired executives Medical facilities extended are quite discriminatory. Executive are extended with Rs 25 lakhs treatment charges for self and spouse besides making payment Rs 36000/ Annually to meet OP charges whereas in case of NCWA employees it is ₹ 5Lakhs/8Lakhs for treatments and there is no other payment for OP charges etc.

In view of the above we request your good office to intervene in the matter and advise Singareni Collieries Company Limited authorities to extend Medical facilities to all Retired employees without any discrimination for which act of kindness we shall be ever grateful to you sir.
