To All The Unions/Federation of A.I.F.E.E. & OFFICE BEARERS

Sub:- Decisions taken in NCCOEEE Meeting dt 10th Aug.22.

Dear Comrades,

A virtual meeting of NCCOEEE was held on 10th August to discuss and decide the further course of program as the Electricity (Amendment) Bill 2022 is referred to Parliamentary Standing Committee. AIFEE greets its unions and members for whole heartedly participated in agitational program of 'KARYA BAHISHKAR' on 8th August. We are also thankful to all the Members of Parliament, who vehemently apposed passing of the Bill on 8th August. So also we are grateful to Samyukta Kisan Morcha, various trade unions who extended support to our cause and agitation.

Since the bill is now referred to the standing committee NCCOEEE has unanimously decided to prepare memorandum in two parts (A) General comments on adverse implications of the Bill and (B) our clause wise say over the various provisions/sections of the Bill circulated by the Ministry of Power. NCCOEEE has constituted the drafting committee and on behalf of AIFEE, General Secretary is a member.

Every constituent will send a letter to the Chairman, Parliamentary standing committee on Energy, requesting for permission to submit our say, when hearing will be commenced. This draft to all constituents will be sent separately by AIFEE office.

Decision For Wider Campaign

Reference of Bill 2022 to standing committee should not be taken as a sole victory. This is the first step to achieve the decided goal all the constituents unions/federations have to start wider campaign propagating the adverse implications of the Bill. Therefore without any further delay our campaign must start. NCCOEEE have decided three stages of campaign (A) start meetings, Melawas, Seminars at District Level (B) Arrange state level conventions and elaborate the adverse effects of Bill on consumers, farmers, consumers below poverty line etc and ill effects on the development of state. (C) NCCOEEE will arrange at National level and those instructions will be given separately.

(A) Meetings at District level of Employees & Engineers- Time scheduled Mid August-Sept.22

(B) Convention involving all section of consumers namely peasants, workers, employees, youth women including people's representatives, delegates from Civil society like dignified persons, Teachers, Students, Lawyers, Engineers, Doctors, journalists, Press & Media. They should be invited through their respective organisation and eminent persons of the locality by name. This should be in October.

This National level campaign titled **Bijlee Kranti Yatra** will be started from Varanasi on 2nd November, 2022. In this level participants will be as under:

(A) All members of National Chapter.

(B) 2/3 members of State Chapters including convener. There will be a plenary meeting of NCCOEEE members as above (A) & (B) & representatives of UP State Chapter.

In the second half of the day, a mass convention will take place. A Delegation will visit PMO of Varanasi with proper appointment to hand over NCCOEEE Memorandum addressed to the Prime Minister of India.

National Campaign will be continued throughout the month of November in the major cities and adjacent districts and be culminated at Delhi - during winter Session of the Parliament. The culmination of this rally Bijlee Kranti Yatra will be a massive one comprising of Electricity Consumers, Employees and Engineers in a suitable ground / public place in the city of Delhi.

All state & District Chapter of NCCOEEE will resume their mass awareness campaign in parallel to **Bijlee Kranti Yatra** from 3rd November to 30th November. Object of these phase of campaign will be to reach all District / Sub-Divisional Towns, Block / Taluka Headquarters and villages as much as possible. **In order to make these program successful, co-operation from National and state organisations struggling to oppose Sale of India in the name of National Monetisation Pipeline(NMP) under the veil of Azadi Ka Amrit Mohatsav and Atmanirbhar Bharat will be sought for.**

If despite our strong apposition the Govt proceed further for inactment of the Electricity (Amendment) Bill 22, NCCOEEE will give a call for indefinite strike in the Power sector. All the constituents are requested to seriously go through the program and act expeditiously without any loss of time.
