Subject: - Strike Notice of Power Employees and Engineers against Parallel License to Adani Electrical Navi Mumbai Ltd.

Respected Sir,

Kindly refer to AIPEF Letter No. 98-2022 dated 25.12.2022, 101-2022 dated 29.12.2022 & 102-2022 dated 31.12.2022 on the subject referred above vide which you were requested to kindly intervene so that Parallel License of electricity distribution to Adani Electricals Navi Mumbai Ltd. in the working area of MSEDCL is rejected in the larger interest of electricity consumers of Maharashtra state.

It has also been learnt that Torrent Power has also applied for parallel licenses at Kalyan, Vasai, Pune, Nagpur, Pimpri Chinchwad Ministry Corporation and also a big Chakan MIDC near Pune. Besides this it has also been learnt that Tata Power has submitted an expression of interest to Government of Maharashtra for taking over the electricity distribution of Aurangabad, Jalana on PPP basis.

This is very alarming situation for Power Sector of Maharashtra as about 50% of the total revenue is coming from these areas in MSEDCL. If these all areas are handed over to private companies then MSEDCL will become totally bankrupt and will have no money even to purchase electricity for common consumers.

You are also kindly aware that Joint Action Committee (JAC) of Power Employees & Engineers of Maharashtra has already submitted a notice of 72 Hours token Strike w.e.f. 4th January 2023 and indefinite strike w.e.f. 18th January 2023. In continuation to AIPEF references, Haryana Power Engineer's Association (HPEA) also wants to inform you that Power Employees & Engineers across the country including that of Haryana are whole heartedly supporting the movement of Maharashtra Power Employees & Engineers. In case, Maharashtra Power Employees & Engineers are forced to proceed on strike then no employee or Engineer from Haryana will be available to maintain the power supply of Maharashtra and they will be forced to resort in support of striking power employees and Engineers of Maharashtra, the responsibility of which shall be solely of Maharashtra Government.
