Subject: Notice

Sir,

I have been directed to submit that a meeting of Joint Front of HPSEBL Employees & Engineers was held today and the following demands were endorsed unanimously in continuation to a Notice dt. 18th October, 2024 for kind consideration and further action:-

1. To restore all 51 posts of engineering cadre abolished vide notification dt. 16.10.2024.
2. To withdraw retrenchment orders of 81 Nos. outsourced staff working against the post of driver from the last 10-12 years in various units of HPSEBL.
3. To implement Old Pension System in HPSEBL without further delay.
4. To adhere the provisions of a Bipartite Agreement annexed to HPSEB Transfer Scheme, 2010 executed between the Govt. of HP and Joint Front of HPSEBL Employees & Engineers in letter and spirits and no asset(Line, Sub Station, Power Houses etc.) be transferred to other entity without consultation with the Joint Front of HPSEBL E&E.
5. To initiate selection process for 1030 posts of T/mate already approved by the HPSEBL-Service Committee of HPSEBL and recruitment for posts lying vacant in HPSEBL.
6. To release arrears of pension & salary to the employees/ pensioners accrued consequent upon the 7th Pay Commission.

7. To release all the pending terminal benefits, payments of employees and pensioners with further delay

It has been noticed that the management of HPSEBL is reluctant on the issues raised in previous notice dt. 18.10.2024 and there is strong resentment amongst the employees and engineers of HPSEBL resulting in constrained to launch mass action in favours above demands throughout state from 28th October, 2024 by holding demonstration/ rallies.

Front hopes that the Govt. of HP and management of State Power Board will come forward with deep sense of responsibility and will resolve these longstanding issues within the notice period in order to maintain industrial peace. However, on failure of the same, Joint Front will be compelled to further intensify its action in the state.
