Sub: Nationwide General Strike Call by Joint Platform of Central Trade Unions-reg.

The Affiliates are aware that the Joint Platform of Central Trade Unions under the Chairmanship of INTUC President has decided for Nationwide General Strike on 9th July, 2025 against 04 Labour Codes, Privatization, Outsourcing of perennial nature of activities and demanding restoration of Old Pension Scheme for Central Government Employees.

As the demands listed by CTUs are concerning all categories of working class including Railwaymen/Women, NFIR has since decided to advice its Affiliates to organize demonstrations and rallies on 9th July, 2025b at various levels in support of the demands of CTUs. The pending demands concerning Rail Workforce which are yet to be resolved satisfactorily are listed below to enable the Affiliates to highlight the same during protest, rallies/demonstrations to be held on 9th July, 2025:-

List of demands:

- Restoration of Old Pension Scheme in Railways.
- Finalization of Terms of Reference of 8th CPC as suggested by JCM/NFIR.
- Withdraw ban on creation of posts in Railways.
- Stop privatization, outsourcing and contractorization in Railways.
- Create new posts for newly built assets in Railways.
- Improve service conditions of various categories of railway employees.
- Expedite Cadre Restructuring and upgradation of all categories of Railway employees.
- Resolve pending demands in the fora of PNM and JCM quickly.

NFIR is confident that the Affiliates would mobilize railway employees for successful conduct of rallies/demonstrations peacefully and constitutionally on the above demands. Report on the programme conducted be sent to Federation's office.
