To all Central Office Bearers and General Secretaries

Dear Comrades.

Sub: Decisions of CWC meeting held at Phulera on 4th & 5th August 2025.

The meeting was presided by the presidium headed by Com. Ram Raj Bhagat our CP. 55, central committee members from 16 zones attended. 30 delegates took part in the discussion on the reports and agenda. The following decisions were taken in the meeting.

A. Programme of action

- 1. **Right Proclamation Convention. Meeting reiterated the decision** of CWC/Delhi meeting to organize right proclamation convention in all zones. Therefore, the remaining zones those did not hold the convention must organize this convention within three months and inform accordingly.
- 2. **Demonstration before GM office on 4**th **September**. To pursue the increase of running allowance by 25% and increase in ceiling limit of IT exemption to Rs 31, 000/-.A memorandum is to be submitted to CRB through the GM. Draft will be prepared by centre. **Note:** If any zone wishes to conduct this program on a different date, they may adjust it accordingly
- 3. **48 hours' hunger fast from 10 AM on 2nd December. All running staff shall observe** On duty/ off duty fast from 10 AM on 2nd December if the running allowance rates are not increased & IT ceiling limit increased to Rs. 31000/-. All zones and divisions may serve notice to railway administration in addition to Centre.
- 4. **Mass signature campaign.** A mass signature campaign on the duty hours, 16+30 PR, night duty, out station stay & stabling duties shall be organised after completion of the zonal right proclamation convention, to seek presidential intervention. Date will be advised later.

Organisational decisions

- **B. Membership:** The target to complete the 2025 membership drive is September. Membership statement signed by branch Secretary, president & treasurer, counter foils of receipts and central quota shall be sent to central Treasurer before 30th September.
- **C. 8 CPC:** Each zone should prepare their additions and decisions to 7th CPC memorandum and send it to the 8th CPC WhatsApp group within three months for the consideration of the drafting committee.
- **D.** Observe 13th August as Victory Day, every branch should organize a program to educate the cadre about the cause, course and achievements 1973 AILRSA strike.
- E. Observe 15 September as Com. Dhar remembrance day. The birth & death anniversary of beloved Com. S. K. Dhar shall be observed in all branches with gate meeting, TU class, Blood donation etc.
- **F.** National women running staff convention. Each zone shall prepare the list of women running staff and create a zonal WhatsApp group immediately. Organize zonal convention and form a zonal sub committee as a prelude to the national convention. Central women's sub committee & central organising secretaries shall undertake this task.
- **G.** The National Safety Convention will be held jointly with the sister trade unions. It is being considered to hold it along with the next CWC meeting. Central office bearers shall contact the central leaders of all sister trade unions in their zone,
- **H.** with this proposal and get back the feed back to centre.
- I. History Committee A copy of the draft prepared by Com. Harcharan Singh will be sent to each zone. All zones can send their suggestions/corrections to the next CWC along with their nominee to the history committee. The history committee then finalize the draft.
- J. Steps to attract new recruits In the coming days, new recruits from RRB will reach the running staff training centres. Organization members should be sent to these training centres to explain how the number of vacancies increased from 5699 to 17966 and invite them to AILRSA.
- **K. NPS/ UPS sub committee.** The previously formed NPS/UPS committee is not functioning effectively. It must be made active and operational.
- L. Generation of PAN card branch/division/zone whose PAN card is made only in the name of "ALL INDIA LOCO RUNNING STAFF ASSOCIATION" should correct it adding the name of the branch/division/zone as well, at the earliest, as this is causing problems in central auditing/filing ITR.
- M. Financial decisions. It has been decided to provide financial assistance of ₹50,000/- for the TU class held in HYD and ₹2,30,000/- for the D&AR class held in Surendranagar. The expenses for CWC/FL (other than fooding), amounting to ₹1,75,035/- (One lakh seventy-five thousand and thirty-five rupees), will also be borne by the Central fund. Travelling expenditure of Rs. 5850/- will be reimbursed to Com. N. B Dutta.
- N. WR zonal committee shall make a complete report on the case at Central Labour Tribunal, Mumbai, filed by the Nandurbar branch demanding 16+2 HQ rest, for the consideration of Central Committee. Rs.
- O. AILRSA CLENDAR. Regarding the printing of the AILRSA calendar, discussions were held in the CWC meeting. Zones must send the estimated printing cost to the Central office. Once the decision to print is made, the expenses will be shared equally (50%-50%) between the Central office and the zones.
- **P.** Next CWC meeting. Decided to hold the next CWC meeting extended to Secretary/ President/ Treasurer of all divisions& branches, at Puri in January 2026.
