PRESS STATEMENT

Bhubaneswar 01/01- The Platinum Jubilee Year 27th General Conference of the All India Insurance Employees' Association (AIIEA) concluded successfully today at Bhubaneswar after five days of intensive deliberations. The historic conference, marking 75 years of the organisation's dedicated service to the insurance employees' movement and the cause of public sector insurance, was attended by around 2,000 delegates and observers from across the country.

The Conference reviewed the current challenges confronting the public sector insurance industry and the working people of India. Expressing serious concern over policies aimed at weakening public sector institutions, the Conference unanimously resolved to intensify nationwide campaigns for the protection and strengthening of the public sector insurance industry, recognising its critical role in providing social security and financial stability to the masses.

The Conference decided to extend full support and solidarity to the strike call given by the Central Trade Unions on 12th February 2026 against the anti-worker labour codes, which undermine hard-won labour rights and seek to dilute job security, collective bargaining, and social protection. It also resolved to express strong solidarity with the proposed strike action of PSGI employees on 9th January 2026 demanding immediate notification of the long-pending wage revision.

Recognising the importance of organisational strengthening and leadership development, the Conference resolved to organise trade union schools at various levels to impart ideological clarity, organisational skills, and awareness of contemporary challenges. Special emphasis will be laid on grooming young leaders to ensure continuity, vibrancy, and effectiveness of the movement in the years ahead.

The Platinum Jubilee Conference reaffirmed AIIEA's unwavering commitment to defending the interests of insurance employees, strengthening public sector insurance, and upholding democratic and trade union rights through united and sustained struggle. The Conference profusely thanked Bhubaneswar Division Life Insurance Employees' Association and the Reception Committee for successfully organising the Conference.

The Conference unanimously elected Dharmaraj Mohapatra from Raipur as the President, Shreekanta Mishra from Hyderabad as the General Secretary and B.S. Ravi from Hyderabad as the Treasurer for the ensuing term.
