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Charter of Demands

1. Implement 8th Pay Commission from 01.01.2026 and provide the benefit of Rs. 54000/- basic pay to all central employees.
2. The risk and hardship allowance of track maintainer employees should be increased to 30 percent of the basic Pay.
3. Scrap the Four Labour Codes.
4. Trackmen should be promoted to 4600/- GP under cadre restructuring process.
5. Track maintenance staff going on night patrol should be given a patrolling allowance of Rs 1,000/-per day.
6. Overtime allowance should be implemented for all railway employees if they work for more than 8 hours.
7. Keyman and Patrolman employees should be provided with "RAKSHAK Device" as soon as possible to prevent them from being run-over.
8. Keeping in mind the safety of night patrolmen and railway safety, the patrolling beat should be made at least 1 km long.
9. As per fundamental rights, all trackmaintainer employees should be given equal opportunities for promotion to the posts of Station Master, TTE, CC, ALP etc. through LDCE examinations.
10. Fill up vacant posts through Open Market Recruitment of all cadres in all the Departments, stop outsourcing and corporatization in Govt. Departments.
11. Merge 50% DA/DR with Basic Pay/Pension, Grant 20% of Pay/Pension as an Interim Relief (IR) w.e.f. 1.1.2026.
12. Scrap NPS/UPS, Restore OPS for all Employees.
13. Withdraw the Draft Seed Bill 2025 and Electricity Amendment Bill 2025.
14. Release the installments (18 months) of DA/DAR frozen during Covid pandemic to Employees and Pensioners.
15. Restore MNREGA and repeal the Develop India – Employment and Livelihood Mission (Rural) Act, 2025.
16. Remove 5% Ceiling imposed on Compassionate Appointment, grant Compassionate Appointment in all cases to wards/Dependants of Deceased employees.
17. Kilometer allowance for running staff employees should be increased by 25% as per the increased 50% DA from 01.01.2024.
18. The right of workers to organise, form unions, have fair movement and strike must be ensured.
