Subject: Constitution of Working Group to examine comments/suggestions on draft Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2025 and to finalise the draft Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2025.

It has been decided to constitute a Working Group to examine all stakeholder comments and suggestions received on draft Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2025 during the consultation process and to finalise the draft Bill accordingly. The Draft Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2025 was issued for stakeholder consultations on 09.10.2025 requesting stakeholder comments/suggestions till 30.11.2025.

2. Composition of the Working Group

3. Terms of Reference (TOR)

- i. To examine, analyse, and synthesise comments and suggestions received from stakeholders on the draft Bill and related proposals.
- ii. To refine and finalise the draft Bill, including definitions, enabling provisions, transitional clauses, and delegated legislative powers, ensuring clarity, precision, and implementability.
- iii. To prepare or vet the Statement of Objects and Reasons, Explanatory Notes, and any other supporting documents required for legislative approval.
- iv. To complete its deliberations and submit the final draft Bill along with a summary of key changes and rationale to the Ministry of Power within the stipulated timeframe.

4. The Working Group may co-opt any member, if required. The Group will submit its recommendation within 14 days of its formation.
5. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
