THE ORGANISATIONAL DECISIONS OF THE EXTENDED CWC MEETING
HELD AT PURI ON 28/29-01-2026.

Dear Comrades,

The extended Central Working Committee Meeting of our Association was held at Puri, ECoR, on 28th & 29th January 2026. The meeting was a mini-Conference with a participation of 900 people including family members. There was a public meeting held at 17:00 hours on the first day and it was inaugurated by Com. Janardhan Pathi, President of CITU-State Committee, Odisha and was presided by Com. R. R. Bhagath. Sri. R. C. Sahoo, GS of ECoRSC (NFIR), GS of AIGC, Com. Paraskumar (JSG) Com. Danda pat Ex. GS & others addressed the gathering.

The CWC meeting was controlled by Presidium consisting of Comrades RR Bhagath, com. T. Hanumaiah, L. Mony, Ram sharan & BSVV Raju. A total number of 51 delegates from 16 railways participated in the debate on the Secretary Generals' Report, Treasurers Report, Draft Resolutions, and program of action etc.,

(A).PROGRAMME OF ACTION

1.Parliament Dharna (at Janthar Manthar) on 27th March 2026 at 09am to 1 PM.

This Dharna program is taken to intensify the fight against the unjust denial of increased TA to running staff and unlawful recovery of IT for the TA from running staff. The Posters & leaflets shall be released by zonal committee. Memorandum will be prepared by centre. All MPs, including Rajya Sabha shall be met before 5th March by the leaders in their locality and seek the support.

2.The CWC meeting will be held at 14.00 hours on 27/03/2026.

After the Parliament March, we have decided to conduct intensive campaign and field level preparation to claim the basic rights in July – August monsoon session of the parliament and to start availing them in November – December Winter session of the parliament, to press our 16-point Charter of demands. The time table for tour of central office bearers, various organizational programmes to embolden running staff to claim the rights, formation of action committee to guide the agitation etc will be finalized in the CWC meeting.

3. National Right Proclamation Convention on 28th March.

Almost all zones have already resolved to wage a Do or Die agitation to achieve the charter of basic demands we have decided in our last Delhi CWC meeting. Now, the declaration of

the same is decided in National level. National Rights Proclamation Convention will be held on 28th March at 09.00 AM at Delhi.

(B). Extending Solidarity to 12th February General Strike.

National co- ordination committee of Central Trade Unions (CTU), Independent National Federations & Samyukta Kisan Morcha have declared one day strike on 12th February, to protest against the anti – working class & anti people policies of the Government such as, 4 Labour Codes, privatisation, NPS / UPS, Electricity amendment bill, Seed Bill, Abolition of Employment Guarantee Schemes(MNREGA) etc. The CWC Meeting decided to extend support to the strike through lobby level demonstrations on 12/03/26, inviting all the likeminded trade unions.

(C). ORGANISATIONAL DECISIONS

1).MNP Remembrance Day on 11th February 2026.

Com. M N Prasad's death anniversary falls on 11.02.2026.On this day each branch shall organise a programme and disseminate information regarding the sacrifice, dedication and struggle filled life of the comrade.

2).Welcoming of RRB recruits.

An organisational team should visit the training centres and welcome the new recruits to AILRSA. The booklet prepared by Southern Railway may be printed and distributed to them. NWR decided to supply "The Plight of Loco men" to all. If desired, documents highlighting the achievements of your zone may also be attached with this booklet.

3). Hindi FIRE

A committee has been formed to restart publishing of FIRE in Hindi, with the following members.- Com. R. K. Rana, Com. R. C. Chaudhry, Com. F. Alam, Com. Ranjit Kumar, Com. S. Sur, Com. Arun Kumar Pandey, Com. Ramesh Kr, Com. D. P. Bharti, Com. O. P. Meena, Com. Paras Kumar. Any other comrades from the zones who wish to join the committee may also do so. This committee shall meet immediately on virtual platform and analyse our experience and place a workable plan for restoration & maintenance of the official organ in Hindi. Com. Paraskumar shall take the responsibility to coordinate and report concrete proposals to next central committee meeting.

(4).The 4th Batch of TU class at Central School of TU education Hyderabad.

The next TU Class will be held in first week of June. There will be separate class rooms for Hindi & English medium trainees. Zonal units of Central, North & West may take extra efforts to nominate members to the training programme.

(5).Review of organisational strength.

All zones shall fill and submit the Organisational Status Form to the Central Committee immediately. Along with this, each branch must also prepare and submit data regarding curtailment of duty hours to the Central body.

(6). Re- printing of Plight of Loco men

Decided to reprint Plight of Loco men in Hindi language as NWR demanded 3000 copies. Other Zones shall estimate their demand and inform Com. Paraskumar within 20th February. Zones shall pay Rs 30/- per copy and rest will be borne by centre.

(7).The 8th CPC Memorandum

Each zone has been provided with a draft memorandum on the 8th CPC. Zones shall give their views on it, and if any additions or corrections are required, they may inform the Central Committee through a representation.

(8). History Committee

A copy of the draft on AILRSA history was supplied to all zones. The following Comrades are nominated to initiate discussions with veterans in the respective zone and secure records for improvement of the draft within six months. Comrades Sivakumar (NR), D. S. Koparkar (CR), KC Sudheer (SCR), P. Vijayakumar(SR), VBSV Raju (ECoR), Paul Munera(SWR), R. C. Choudhary(NWR), S. Biswas(SER), J. N. Sha(NER), A. B. Thappa(ER), Sewaram Meena (NCR), A. K. Raut(ECR), H. S. Bhaduria(SECR), Muneeram Meena(WR). NFR, WCR& METRO shall nominate their representative to this committee. S G propose Com. Sudheer (SCR)Phone No. 9491906290 to co- ordinate this committee. All GS are requested to share the phone numbers of the representative to Com. Sudheer.

(9)Membership statements & used receipt books.

All the zonal railways who did not submit the membership statement and used books, had agreed to send the same to central office within a week or in a fortnight.

10) Joint meeting of SCR and ECoR on formation of SCoR.

Decided to convene a joint meeting of SCR and ECoR to sort out the grievances of loco running staff that may arise out of formation of ECoR and also to form an adhoc committee of AILRSA. Com. S. K Choubey shall coordinate the meeting in mid February.

(C) FINANCIAL DECISIONS

1). ₹1,00,000 (one lakh) shall be released from central fund for the 3rd batch of TU Class held on 16,17 &18thof September.

2). For the CWC Extended Meeting at Puri / ECoR on 28 & 29 January 2026, ₹3,00,000/- (three lakhs) has been approved as support towards food expenses as large number of families reached there, and ₹2,00,000/- (two lakhs) towards delegate accommodation and meeting hall expenses to be borne by the Central. Total amount: ₹5,00,000/-.

3).The travelling expenses of ₹4,160 for Com. N. B. Dutta, Permanent Invitee, to attend the CWC Extended Meeting at Puri/ECoR, will be reimbursed by the Central Committee.
