**Sub:** Request for your intervention to oppose the Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2025  
in Parliament

**Respected Sir/Madam,**

The National Coordination Committee of Electricity Employees & Engineers (NCCOEEEE), a united platform of the National Federations of electricity employees and engineers across the country, most respectfully seeks your kind intervention regarding the proposed Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2025.

We have received information that the Government is planning to introduce and pass the said Bill in Parliament shortly, despite strong objections raised by all electricity employees' and engineers' organisations. These objections have been repeatedly conveyed through various communications and meetings, and were also strongly expressed during the stakeholders' meeting convened by the Ministry of Power on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2026.

It is shocking to note that the Bill is reportedly being placed on the basis of the recommendations of a Working Group in which the All India DISCOMs Association (AIDA) is a constituent. AIDA has been consistently advocating in favour of the proposed amendments from the very beginning. Therefore, its inclusion in a Working Group meant to independently examine the matter raises serious concerns about the objectivity and fairness of the process.

The proposed amendments to the Electricity Act will have far-reaching implications for the power sector, the electricity workforce, and most importantly for the common people of our country. We apprehend that the Bill will pave the way for further privatisation and fragmentation of the state electricity distribution sector, adversely affecting the accessibility and affordability of electricity for millions of consumers, particularly the poor, farmers, and small consumers.

In view of the above, we earnestly request you to kindly raise strong objections in Parliament against the introduction and passage of the Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2025. Your support in defending the interests of the electricity sector, its workforce, and the millions of consumers dependent on it will be of immense importance.
