Subject: Appeal for Immediate Resolution of Issues Raised by Haryana Bijli Karamchhari Evam Engineer Sanyukt Sangharsh Morcha and Withdrawal of Anti-Public Power Sector Measures.

Hon'ble Chief Minister Sir,

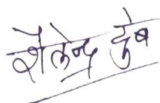
I am writing on behalf of the All India Power Engineers Federation (AIPEF), the apex national federation representing power engineers working in CEA & State / UT Power Utilities across the country.

2. AIPEF has taken serious note of the strike notice served by the Haryana Bijli Karamchhari Evam Engineer Sanyukt Sangharsh Morcha regarding the proposed three-day statewide strike from 11 to 13 August 2026. The notice raises several issues, particularly the proposed segregation of the Agriculture DISCOM and the move to grant a parallel electricity distribution licence to Eleven Power Private Limited for Gurugram and Nuh.
3. AIPEF extends its full and unequivocal support to the legitimate concerns and demands of the employees and engineers of Haryana Power Utilities. We firmly believe that the proposed creation of an Agriculture DISCOM and the introduction of a parallel distribution licensee are nothing but steps towards the gradual fragmentation and privatization of the public electricity distribution system. Such measures will adversely affect consumers, farmers, employees and the long-term financial sustainability of the State utilities.
4. Creating parallel distribution structures will result in cream-skimming of profitable consumers, weaken public utilities, increase financial stress, and ultimately impose a heavier burden on ordinary consumers. Public power utilities have been built over decades with public investment and should not be weakened in favour of private commercial interests.
5. We respectfully urge the Government of Haryana to initiate immediate and meaningful dialogue with the representatives of the Haryana Bijli Karamchhari Evam Engineer Sanyukt Sangharsh Morcha and resolve the issues amicably before the situation escalates into an industrial dispute.
6. At the same time, AIPEF wishes to convey, with utmost responsibility, that if the engineers and employees of Haryana Power Utilities are compelled to proceed with the proposed strike due to the failure of the Government to address their genuine concerns, the Power Engineers across the country will extend their full support and solidarity to their Haryana counterparts.

7. In such an eventuality, no Power Engineer from any State Power Utility in the country will be available to assist in maintaining or operating the power system of Haryana during the period of industrial action.
8. Further, we sincerely hope that the Government will refrain from adopting any coercive or vindictive measures against employees and engineers exercising their democratic and trade union rights through peaceful agitation. However, if any victimisation, disciplinary action, or other punitive measures are initiated against the peacefully agitating employees and engineers of Haryana, AIPEF will be compelled to launch nationwide supportive organisational actions to safeguard their legitimate rights and dignity. The entire responsibility for any such nationwide developments shall rest solely with the Government of Haryana.
9. We once again appeal to your good office to intervene personally, withdraw the proposals relating to the Agriculture DISCOM and the parallel distribution licence, restore confidence among the employees and engineers, and ensure that industrial peace and uninterrupted power supply are maintained in the larger public interest.

We look forward to your positive intervention.
