Sub: ORGANIZATIONAL RESOLUTIONS & DECISIONS of CWC MEETING HELD AT NAGPUR on
Dated 19th & 20th July 2026

1. Claiming of Rights & Privileges from Human Rights Day – 10th December 2026

This meeting decided to implement the decision of Right Proclamation convention to claim the following
5 basic Rights/Privilege from 10th Dec 2026 i.e. **The International Human Rights Day.**

- (A) 30 hours Periodical Rest in addition to 16 hours Headquarters Rest when PR becomes due.
- (B) Will demand Night Rest after two continuous night duties.
- (C) Will demand to return to Headquarters within 36 hours Outstation Stay.
- (D) Will demand relief from duty on completion of 9 hours duty from Sign-On.
- (E) Will demand to sanction 30% Leave every day.

It was further decided that to include the "right of 2 hours' preparation time after rest hours" in the campaign.

The following course of action shall be implemented to ensure the participation of each and every running staff in the movement:

- Branch Conventions shall be organized in all Zones where such conventions on these five issues have not yet been conducted within one month.
- The Memo Book and Pamphlets prepared by the Central Committee shall be distributed from 01 December 2026.
- A special Counselling/ monitoring Committee shall be constituted in every Branch Convention. One Monitor shall be nominated for every 25 employees to counsel them and motivate them to submit the claim in writing memo receive in lobby / Lodge abnormalities in CMS / written memo sent on whatsapp of official with remark denied receive memo.
- A responsible Comrade at the Divisional level shall be assigned to monitor the work of all such Monitors.
- Thereafter, Divisional Conventions shall be organized in all Zones in September to November 2026.
- A Mass Signature Campaign shall be conducted from 19 November to 25 November 2026 in support of these six rights/ privileges.
- On 26 November 2026, demonstrations shall be organized at every DRM Office, and the Mass Memorandum on these six demands shall be submitted to the Divisional Railway Manager, along with the signed copies collected during the Mass Signature Campaign.
- Com. L. Mony (CWP) shall prepare the memorandum.

2. Purchase of building for Central Office.

Decided to purchase the property of 913 built up area in the ground floor of the apartment in Paharganj, New Delhi, for the Central Office of the organization in Delhi. The entire process of property acquisition shall be carried out by the General Secretary (GS), Northern Railway (NR) under the supervision of the Secretary General (SG). The office shall be registered for AILRSA "in the name of K. C. James & M. C. Pandey in the capacity of Secretary General & Central Treasurer."

The rest of the cost of the property of Rs. 30,10,000/- will be transferred to the three partners through bank transfer, by issuing three separate cheques of Rs. 16,00,000/-, Rs. 12,00,000/-, & Rs. 2,10,000/-. The cost of stamp paper and registration charges etc. also will be met from central fund.

3. Membership – 2026

The last date for submission of the Membership–2026 Summary Report has been fixed as 30 September 2026. All Zones shall ensure submission of their Summary Reports to the Central Committee within the stipulated time in the prescribed format enclosed.

4. 8th CPC Memorandum

All Zones shall organize Zonal Conventions to educate employees about the 8th CPC Memorandum prepared by the organization. These conventions shall also include programmes on Women Convention, Railway Safety Programme, the shortcomings of NPS/UPS, and campaigns advocating the restoration of the Old Pension Scheme (OPS).

5. Review of Organizational Strength

All Zones shall prepare detailed information regarding their Organizational Strength to the Central Committee in the prescribed format at the earliest. The prescribed proforma has already been circulated to all Zones. A copy of the same shall be forwarded to the Secretary General.

6. Kisan- Mazdoor Convention at Delhi on 29th July 2026

A Convention is being jointly organized by the Central Trade Union and Sanyukta Kisan Morcha on 29 July 2026 at Talkatora Stadium, New Delhi, where issues relating to all sorts of anti-people policy including the Pay Commission, New Labour Code, Pension, and other national labour concerns will be discussed. Comrades from nearby Zones are requested to participate in large numbers and extend their solidarity support.

7. IDT and IRT

A poster campaign shall be conducted on IDT and IRT, demanding that the Administration issue the NOC and order the transfers immediately.

8. Cadre Restructuring

A Branch-level protest programme shall be organized on 13 August 2026 protesting against undue delay in ordering the cadre restructuring of Loco Running cadre.

9. ALP Recruitment – 2024

All Zones shall collect the details to the Central Committee regarding the actual number of newly recruited ALPs who joined service after completing training against the 2024 ALP Recruitment Notification, So that a comparison can be made between the notified vacancies and the actual appointments.

10. Hindi Fire Magazine payment of Second instalment

Second volume of the magazine will be despatched before 15th August. From 15 August to 30 September 2026, all Zones shall deposit the second instalment amount @ ₹75.00 per copy i.e. 50% of annual subscription, to the Hindi Fire Magazine Committee as per their demand for the Second Edition of the Hindi Fire Magazine.

Each Zone shall also submit the names of 2–3 Comrades who are nominated to receive the bundles of Magazine, to ensure timely distribution. Delays in receiving the Magazine have resulted in payment of Fine Charges, which should be avoided.

11. AILRSA History Book

The draft of the AILRSA History Book was circulated to all Zones for corrections and suggestions. All Zones shall make a write up on their comments and suggestions to the Central Committee by 30 September 2026 to facilitate publication of the book.

12. TU Class

The next TU Class will be held at Secunderabad from 4th to 6th December 2026. All Zones are requested to send the maximum possible number of Comrades to participate.

Note: The next D&AR Class will be organized in ECR. Detailed information will be communicated later.

13. PAN Card

All Zones where a PAN Card has been obtained in the name of AILRSA shall complete the process of surrendering the PAN Card at the earliest and intimate the Central Treasurer accordingly. Decided to give NOC to ZWC of NCR & ER to apply for a separate PAN in their favour.

14. Financial Decision

- (A) The TU Class held at Secunderabad in June 2026 recorded lower-than-expected participation, resulting in a deficiency of ₹50,000. It was unanimously decided that the Central Committee would bear its one-third share amounting to ₹47,880, making a total contribution of ₹97,880.
- (B) Financial assistance of ₹1,44,800/- shall be extended from central fund towards the expenditure of Rent of hall and accommodation of CWC meeting held on 19th & 20th July 2026 at NAGPUR.
- (C) Travelling expenditure of Rs. ₹4,840/- for Com. N. B. Dutta for attending CWC Meeting will be borne by central committee.

15. Next CWC Meeting will be held at AGRA/NCR Zone in November 2026.
